

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Melbourne IT is committed to operating in an environmentally sound and sustainable manner. Our goal is to support and develop best practice in caring for the environment. We have invested in building a culture in which environmental management is everyone's responsibility, and in which we are open and responsive to our community's environmental concerns. To support our goals we have nominated an Environmental Issues Officer to assist us in continuously reviewing our operations.

Waste and Recycling

Melbourne IT is focused on improving the efficiency of our resource use. Recycling schemes now include the recycling of toners, cardboard and paper, and where possible the company chooses to use second hand and recycled equipment and supplies such as paper and furniture. We provide many processes and procedures online such as payroll, memos, internal requisitions etc to reduce paper usage. De-commissioned computer equipment is either recycled for re-use or donated to charity.

Energy

Melbourne IT has implemented policies to conserve energy including ensuring that building lights are turned off when offices are closed, and that all personal computers are turned off when not in use. Employees are encouraged to adopt personal working practices that support energy conservation.

Transport

Our offices are located in major cities close to public transport allowing employees to choose public transport options when commuting with the effect of supporting reduction in fuel emissions and global warming. Many employees choose to ride bicycles to work and where practical are provided with shower and bike rack facilities.

Building

Air-conditioning units are monitored regularly to ensure a high level of air quality is provided to our staff and visitors, and to assist in providing a healthy work environment.
